

Basic Life Support (BLS) AND First Aid Training Egyptian Red Crescent

First Aid Training:

First aid is the immediate aid provided to a sick or injured person until medical treatment can be provided. It generally consists of series, simple life-saving medical techniques that anyone even a non-doctor or lay person can be trained to perform with minimal equipment.

Everyone will be prepared to react and provide urgent care properly during an emergency or accident. Preventative measures are also taught to decrease the likelihood of accidents at the workplace.

Duration of the training course:

Two days (from 09:00 AM to 04:00 PM daily).

Training course curriculum:

Theoretical part:

- I. Primary survey (initial assessment).
- II. BLS, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) in Adults and infants and use of AED.
- III. Relief of choking in adults, children and infants.
- IV. Heart attack & Stroke.
- V. Bleeding, injuries.
- VI. Burns.
- VII. Fractures, Muscle, Bone and Joint Injuries.
- VIII. Head and spinal injuries.
- IX. Shock
- X. Fainting and coma.

- XI. Diabetic emergencies.
- XII. Convulsions.
- XIII. Poisoning.
- XIV. Bites and stings.
- XV. Heat related emergencies.
- XVI. Cold related emergencies

Practical part:

- i. Primary survey (initial assessment) and Recovery position.
- ii. BLS, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) in Adults and infants using training manikins.
- iii. Relief of choking in adults, children and infants.
- iv. First aid for heart attack.
- v. First aid for bleeding, injuries and fractures.
- vi. Emergency splinting and bandaging techniques.

Certification:

A certificate from the Egyptian Red Crescent – Qalubia branch - will be awarded to participants who **fully attend** the course and **passed the written post-test**.

Number of candidates:

Maximum 24 candidates & minimum 12 candidates per course.

Arabic Language
